


WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

Being prepared for the worst-case scenario is essential for you and your family's well-being during a natural disaster. Find out which essential items you should include in your family's preparedness kit.



ANATOMY OF YOUR PREPAREDNESS KIT





Water

One gallon per day. 3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home.



Flashlight + Batteries

LED-powered flashlight.



Emergency Radio Battery-powered NOAA Weather Radio.



Food Supply 3-day supply of non-perishable food.



First Aid + Medication

A first-aid kit is essential for mending injuries and 7-day supply of medications.



Whistle

Include a whistle to signal for help during emergencies.



Sanitation

Anti-bacterial hand sanitizer.



Identification

Copies of personal documents such as medical information, proof of address, or insurance policies.



Cellphone + Charger

Have a cell phone and back up charger for emergency contact.



Money

Extra stash of bills and coins.



Emergency Blanket

Emergency blanket for added warmth.
